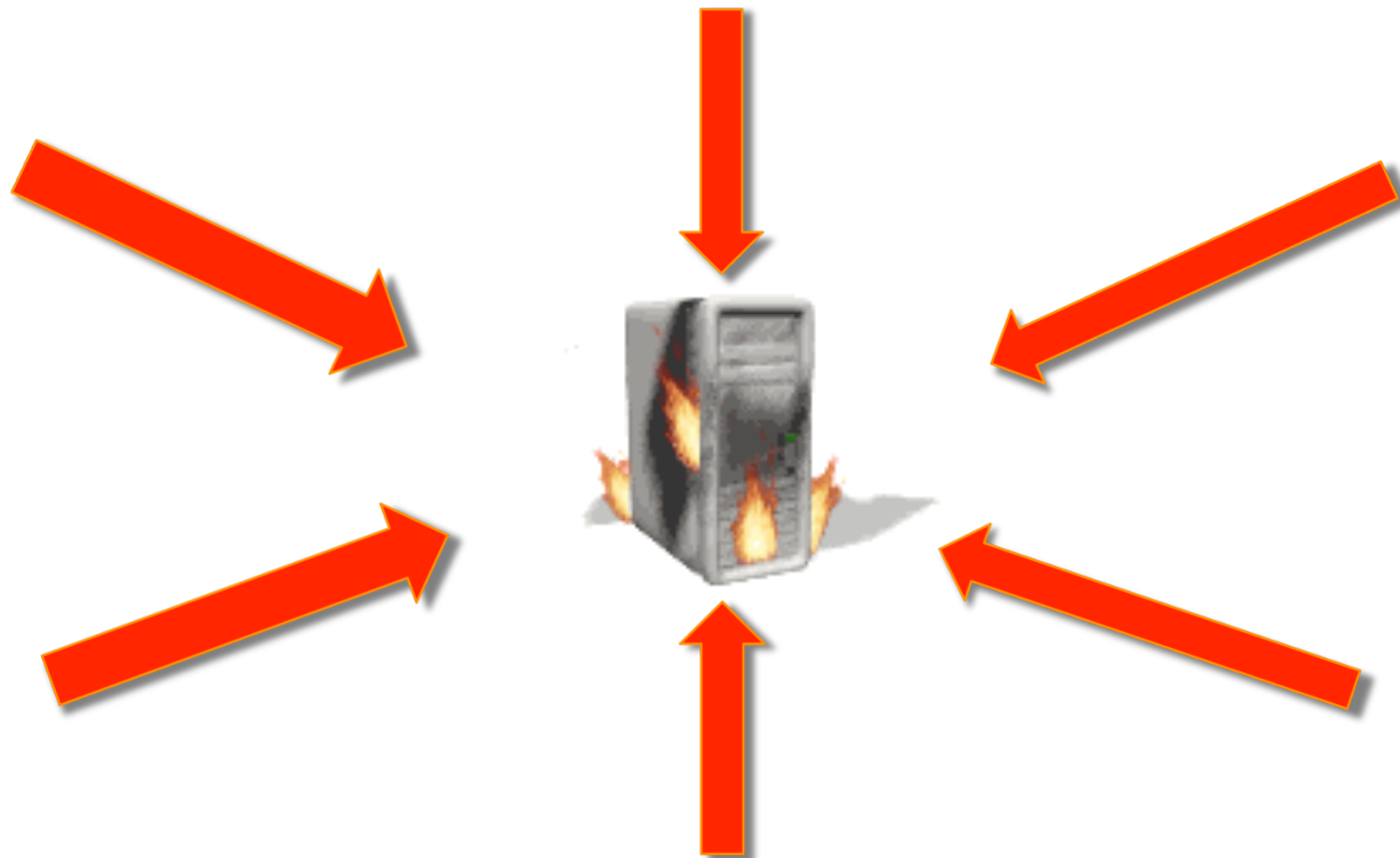

If DNS is under attack... Is it OK to squelch attack?

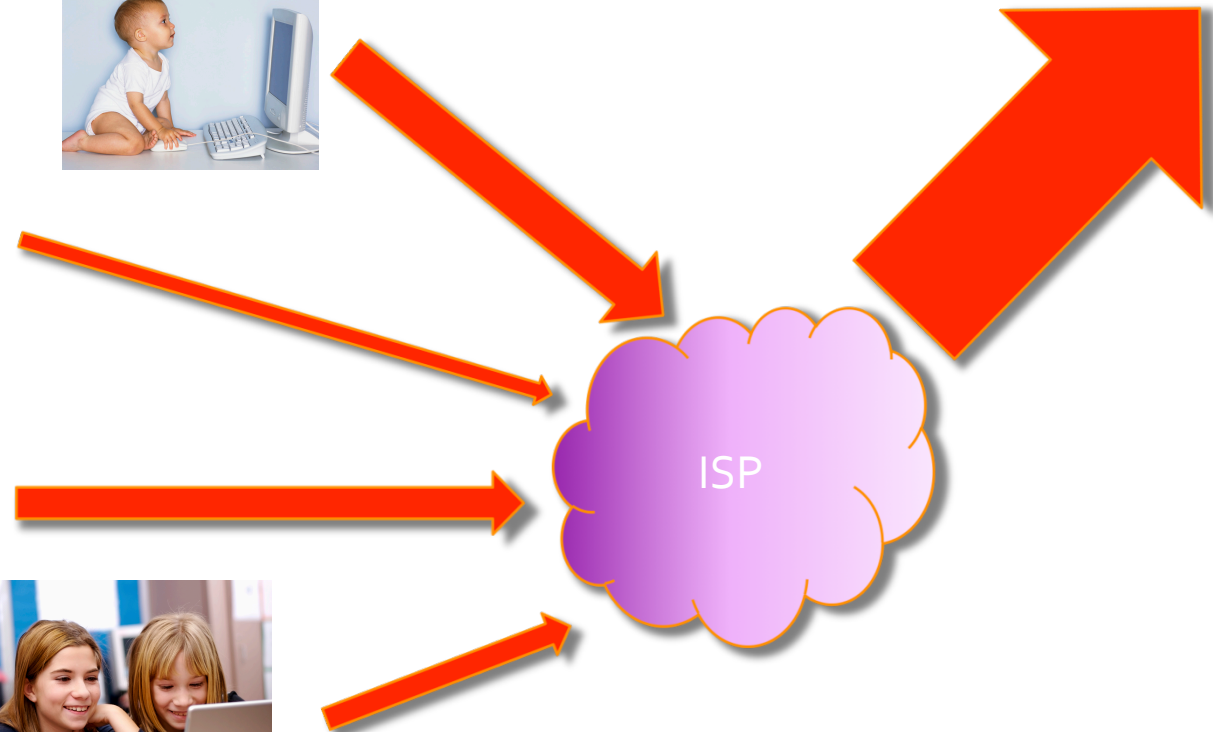
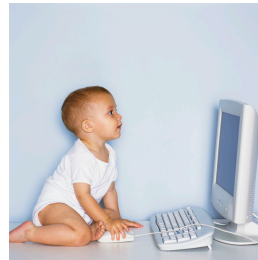


If an enterprise is under attack?...

- + Good for users – need $1/10^{\text{th}}$ BW otherwise
- + Good for ISP – need $1/10^{\text{th}}$ less transit BW

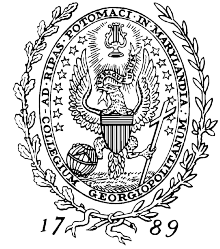
