Basic Definition

- Cloud computing is a model for
 - enabling ubiquitous, convenient, on-demand network access
 - to a shared pool of configurable computing resources (e.g., networks, servers, storage, applications, and services)
 - that can be rapidly provisioned and released with minimal management effort or service provider interaction.

Service Models

- Infrastructure (laaS)
 - Provider offers raw materials
 - Customer provides images, often down to the operating system
- Platform (PaaS)
 - Provider offers application platform
 - Customer builds application in framework
- Software (SaaS)
 - Provider offers soup-to-nuts application
 - Customer might configure application

Private Cloud

- Cloud technology
- Cloud "billing"
- Physically separate infrastructure
 - On premises
 - Off premises
 - Hosted

Community Cloud

- Intra-enterprise or closed community group private cloud
- Exclusive access to underlying infrastructure
 - On a member's premises
 - Off premises
 - Hosted





Public Cloud


- Infrastructure open to public
- Often the business of the provider
- Infrastructure on provider's premises






Hybrid Cloud

- Combination of public, community, or private cloud
- XaaS on-demand scale
 - Otherwise, just cloud point solution






Cloud Computing Today Private / Community Cloud






Cloud Computing Today Hybrid Cloud






Desired State: The InterCloud (Current Georgetown Research)
