






Computer Science Definition of Complex






SIPconnect: A Simplifying Profile






Why SIPconnect? TDM Interconnect Works, but is Bad




IP Interconnect: SIP Trunk (SIPconnect)

SIPit Goal: Find and fix what doesn't work

Fix Bugs in Real Time

- Allows immediate retesting
- High-yield testing
 - Participants claim 4 to 6 months worth of results from 1 week at SIPit

Improve Standards

- If two teams argue over specification, need to clarify specification
- Testing identifies
 errors and omissions
 in the Standards
- Reports from SIPit
 allow the IETF to focus
 on real industry needs


